**What should I bring?**

Traveling Players Ensemble is very excited that you'll be joining us for an **Amphitheatre Overnight!** On Saturday you'll arrive early and take acting and theatre classes all day, breaking for lunch and dinner. We'll build a fire and eat s'mores at night. You'll spend the night in a tent, and get up the next morning ready to perform the short play that you started writing the night before!

We'll provide tents, cooking equipment and plates, etc. Here's what you'll want to bring:

- Walking shoes/sneakers are perfect. Shoes should enclose the toes and give support.
- Dress for the weather! **Layers** of clothes including long underwear (maybe two pairs!), jeans, sweatshirts, jacket and a raincoat with hood, if they're predicting rain. (No umbrellas please!) Please wear clothes that can be "enhanced" with mud and paint. Remember hats, gloves and warm socks!
- Sleepwear as warm as it comes!
- Change of clothes for Sunday.
- A water bottle, so a drink is never far away!
- Medication - If you will be taking medication during the overnight, then please bring it in the prescription bottle and give it to your Troop Leader.
- Bug repellent. Most of the insects and ticks are dead by now, but if you want to be extra careful...
- Paper and pencil or a special notebook to record all your creative ideas.
- Sleeping bag pad, another layer between you and the cold ground.
- Sleeping bag
- Flashlight
- Toiletries - toothbrush, toothpaste, hair brush, etc.
- Backpack/Duffle bag to stuff it all in.

Please **LABEL EVERYTHING** – clothes, water bottles, backpacks, shoes, flashlights, scripts, etc.

If it gets rainy, or, heaven forbid(!), snowy, then we'll spend the night in the barn. Otherwise, we'll go from the fire circle to our tents!
